2, Meeting place

The workshop will be held in the Toyama International Conference Center. The meeting room is on the 2nd floor. The registration desk and reception room are also located on the same floor.

An access map is attached to this bulletin. From the Toyama airport, you can take a bus (400 JPY) bound for "Toyama station" and get off at the "Sogawa" stop, or take a taxi (<3,000 JPY) to either the conference center or the ANA Crowne Plaza Hotel Toyama. Here is the timetable of the bus.

From JR Toyama station, you can take a new streetcar called CENTRAM (Line #3) and get off at the "Kokusai Kaigijou Mae" stop. It will take 6 minutes and the fee is

200 JPY. If you don't have heavy baggage, you can even walk for 15 minutes from the JR Toyama station to the meeting place.

3, Reception and onsite registration

The welcome reception will take place in the Toyama International Conference Center, 2nd floor, on December 13. Upon arrival, you may check in the ANA Crowne Plaza Hotel Toyama at first, and then go to the conference center; this is a one minutes walk to the west. The registration desk and reception will be opened at 6PM and closed at 8:30 PM. For those who cannot arrive by then, the registration desk will be opened at 8:10AM on December 14. The plenary session will start at 9AM on the day.

4, Fee

The conference fee is 30,000 JPY. You are required to pay cash at the registration desk if you haven't paid during online registration. We regret that credit cards are not acceptable at the desk. All participants will receive a receipt of his/her payment at the desk.

If you need any corrections, please let us know as soon as possible.

The allocated time in the program includes discussion session. For the 20 minutes talks, the time includes 3 minutes discussion time, namely
20 minutes = 17 (presentation) + 3 (discussions).

For the talks longer than 20 minutes, allow 5 minutes for discussions.

For the presentation, the LOC will prepare a laptop PC running Windows with PowerPoint 2007 and Adobe Acrobat reader installed. Therefore, we would like to ask you to prepare a compatible file, i.e. Power-Point (.ppt or .pptx) or PDF format. In order not to waste the session time, all talks will be downloaded to this

computer. Therefore, please give your presentation file to the LOC member at the registration desk at least one day prior to your presentation.

All talks will be posted on the workshop website after they have been presented.

7, *Poster Presentations*

Posters should be prepared in A0 size i.e. 840mm(W) x 1188 mm(H), and in portrait format. Poster hanging material will be available at the registration desk. Poster should be posted on December 14th and remain in place during the workshop period. Posters should be removed at the first break on December 16th.

Poster sessions will take place in the evening of December 14th and 15th. All poster presenters are required to stay in front of their posters during the poster sessions.

8, *Weather*

Typical temperature at this time of year in Toyama ranges between 0-15 degrees C. It is recommended to have a jacket, hat, and gloves available for cold weather. We do not expect heavy snow, and thus boots are not necessary.

(Rules for visitors to Kamioka observatory)

● **Safety related**

- Super Kamiokande is located inside a mine and can be a hazardous environment.

● **Behavior inside the mine**

- Follow a designated guide at all times inside the mine. Do not stray from the designated path decided by your guide.
- Do not touch any machines or tools.
- Do not be under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Smoking and fire (e.g. lighters) are not permitted.
- Do not leave garbage.
- If you have a child, hold their hand at all times.
- In the occasion of an emergency like on earthquake or fire, follow the guide's instructions.
- If you feel bad, contact a guide as soon as possible.

● **Clothes and shoes**

- Wear a helmet at all times inside the mine. We will provide you with one.
- You may feel cold inside the mine, (13~15 C on average) we recommend you have a coat.
- Inside the mine, there are steep slopes and uneven floors, so wear comfortable work shoes and clothes. Sandals and slippers are not permitted. Also, there is no running inside the mine. Please mind your step for some slope bases can be slippery.

● **Others**

- Go to the lavatory before you enter.
- Be punctual. We do not permit late visitors.
- It is your responsibility to remain safe at all times. University of Tokyo is not liable for any accidents that might occur.
